

## Portable Travel Games for Car or Plane Travel

### 1. FELT FACE GAME

#### Materials:

- Scissors
- Card stock paper
- Pencil
- Different color felt



1. Draw a basic face shape, eyes, a few different noses, ears, some mouths, eyebrows, accessories like bows and flowers, maybe some glasses, and hair. (I like making them look like family members or add cool accessories like cowboy hats or eye patches).
2. Cut them out and then trace them onto the different color felt.
3. Cut the felt pieces out and stick them in a Ziploc bag.



### 2. Road Trip Travel Magnetic Puzzle

#### Materials

- tape
- craft knife
- jumbo craft (popsicle) sticks
- Old greeting cards, calendars, printed pictures, drawings, etc.
- glue Mod Podge (optional)
- paint brush
- adhesive magnet strips

#### Instructions:

1. Line up jumbo craft sticks side by side on your work surface, and tape them together to hold them in place while you work. A strip of tape across the top and bottom works well. Turn the sticks over.
2. Trim a picture to fit on the craft sticks, and glue it to the center of the sticks.
3. Once the glue is dry, remove the tape from the back of the sticks.
4. Use a knife to cut the picture apart where the sticks meet.
5. Apply a coat of Mod Podge to the top of each picture strip as a sealer. Allow the strips to dry.

6. Cut two small squares of the adhesive magnet strip for each Popsicle stick. Peel the paper backing off and press the sticky side onto the top and bottom of the back of the sticks.

7. Place all the pieces in a small cookie sheet; this makes it perfect for traveling and keeping all the pieces together in the car or plane!
